- Reach out to all our working class white brothers and sisters who due to racial manipulations are often pitted against people of color in a contrived no-win scenario.
- Unite all sectors of the working class to challenge the growing class disparity in America and corporate power in the U.S. The Jordan Journal will not knowingly participate in any factionalism, disunity, or political cannibalism of the left that harms the effort to build a unified front.
- Defend the right of all human beings to explore their spirituality and as such we do not participate in any veiled attacks on people's religious beliefs.

- Preserve and protect the natural environment of the United States and other countries on the planet.
